## The Struggling Reader

- Makes more frequent errors when reading words in a sentence than when reading words in a list
- Has a slow rate of reading that causes comprehension problems
- Thinks that to read a word, one must first understand it rather than arranging the letters and saying the word
- Omits, adds, or confuses words such as **what** for **that**, **of** for **for**, **and** for **the** and other words with similar spellings when reading
- Guesses at words, based on the word's beginning or ending sound
