The student may earn a maximum of two (2) credits in core curriculum courses through the Co-Enrolled program for the 2015-2016 school year only.

Failure to satisfy the above requirements shall require the home school principal (or designee) to deny acceptance of adult education credits earned while Co-Enrolled. (School Board Policy #6000.1)
