INTRODUCTION

Counselors, are you worried about your students not graduating on time with their class? Do your students need to raise their gpa or make up a credit in order to receive their high school diploma? Do they need flexibility to enroll in a course(s)? Help is available for any high school student who is determined to graduate on time. The Co-Enrolled Program is an excellent choice for your students.

- Progress at your own pace
- Improve your GPA
- Graduate with your cohort

ELIGIBILITY

For the 2022-23 SY, the students are required to attend classes face-to-face, and they are responsible for providing their own transportation to class according to their schedule.

Co-Enrolled classes are available to any high school student currently attending a public or private school in Broward County. Students will have the option to attend classes after school (Twilight Program) or in the evening. Classes are offered in the core academic areas: English, Math, Science and Social Studies. To complete graduation requirements, additional credits may be earned providing the following conditions are met:

- ❖ The student must be at risk of not graduating with their 9th grade cohort. The student must be attempting a full load of required credits during the Co-Enrollment period.
- ❖ The student must have written authorization for entrance into each course in the Co-Enrollment program from the home school principal (or designee).
- ❖ The student's credit deficiencies have not resulted from an intentional, willful neglect of studies as determined by the principal (or designee).
- ❖ The student does not have a pattern of excessive absences or habitual truancy or a history of disruptive behavior.
- ❖ The student is limited to two core curricular courses for the 2022-2023 school year. Failure to satisfy the above requirements shall require the home school principal (or designee) to deny acceptance of the education credit earned while enrolled (School Board Policy #6000.1)

PROGRAM LENGTH

The program is open entry/open exit, and is competency based, thus allowing students to progress at their own pace. A course offered in the Co-Enrolled Program is typically offered four hours a day, two days a week. Students are encouraged to utilize free time at home or after scheduled session times to login to their online course platform. This will allow students to complete additional reading assignments and guided notes, helping them to earn a credit/grade towards graduation.



COUNSELOR/DESIGNEE REGISTRATION PROCESS

STEP 1	A student must be referred by their School Counselor or designee
STEP 2	Complete and submit a Co-Enrollment Registration application by visiting www.browardcommunityschools.com and select the “Co-Enrolled Classes” tab
STEP 3	<p>Enter Code in TERMS - A field has been created in TERMS on the A04 panel that will indicate a high school student has been approved to enroll in a Co-Enrolled class. Place a “Y” into the “C” field on the A04 that will flag and transfer data to the Co-Enrolled registration system (FOCUS).</p> 
STEP 4	Allow 24 hours for the system to complete a nightly import prior to the student reporting to campus for class.
STEP 5	Send student to their selected Co-Enrolled location to complete the registration process. <u>This step will require students to report in-person to register and attend class(es).</u>
STEP 6	Counselor/designee will receive confirmation when student officially enrolls and attends the 1 st day of class.
<p>The program is competency based. Students will receive a blend of enrichment while recovering courses via Imagine Learning-Edgenuity Curriculum. Students who complete .5 credit before the end of the term may enroll for an additional course(s) that is listed on the registration application, however there is no guarantee the additional course(s) can be completed in the remaining time.
